



Safeguarding Children at Cranmere Primary School

This school is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and expects all staff and volunteers to share this commitment.

This means that we have a Child Protection Policy and procedures in place which we refer to. All staff (including supply staff, volunteers and governors) must ensure that they are aware of these procedures. Parents and carers are welcome to read the policy on request or by accessing it on our school website, cranmereprimary.org.uk.

Sometimes we may need to share information and work in partnership with other agencies when there are concerns about a child's welfare. We will ensure that our concerns about our pupils are discussed with parents/carers first unless we have reason to believe that such a move would be contrary to the child's welfare or are advised not to do so.

If you are concerned about a child's welfare, please record your concern, and any observations or conversation heard, and report it to one of the DSLs as soon as possible the same day. DO NOT conduct your own investigation.

If your concerns relate to the actions or behaviour of a member of staff (which could suggest that s/he is unsuitable to work with children) then you should report this to the Headteacher (or Deputy in her absence), who will consider what action to take. If the concern relates to the Headteacher, refer the matter to the Chair of Governors.
