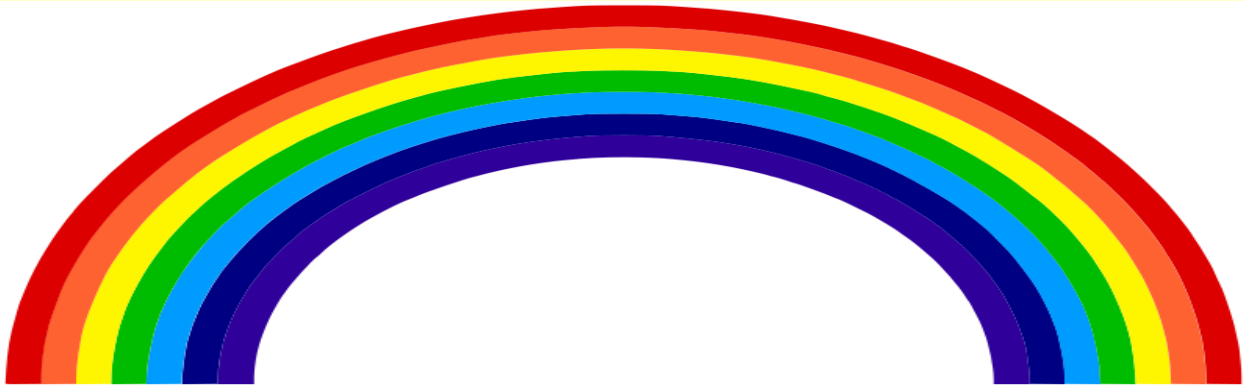


Nursery Rainbows Newsletter

Welcome back and we hope everyone had a Happy Easter. Just a reminder with summer hopefully approaching, remember to provide a named sunhat for your child each day. All day sun cream should be applied before school but if your child is particularly sensitive or the weather is exceptionally hot please bring in named sun cream which your child will need to apply themselves under our supervision

Topics

Our topic this half-term is 'All Creatures Great and Small.' The children will be very busy in our vet role- play attending to the needs of many sick animals! We will be learning about lots of different animals and how to care for them. The books we are using to support our learning are 'Mog and the V.E.T,' 'I Want a Pet,' 'The Three Little fish,' 'Spider!' and 'Hairy Maclary Show business'. Next half term will be providing opportunities to support your child in their transition to Reception. We will be growing and planting some seeds and learning how to care for these.

Phonics

For the children going to Reception in September, we will be learning the SATPIN sounds, please support your child to identify the initial sounds in words with games such as 'I spy' and going on a sound hunt. For the younger children we continue to support their phonics with listening and attention games, learning to differentiate and identify sounds.

Please continue to encourage your child to write their name independently.

How you can help

- Please encourage your child to develop their skills in self-care, by supporting them to put on their own socks and shoes, also learning to do their zip up
- Please bring one piece of fruit only for snack time- named
- Lunch 3 or 4 items of food is enough. (No nuts or nut products)
- Please do not bring in any toys from home.

Every Wednesday we will be continuing to explore our outside environment. Please ensure your children are dressed appropriately for staying outside whatever the weather. Ideally if you are able to purchase a puddle suit or waterproof trousers that would be helpful. If it is warm, Please bring in a sunhat and ensure your child has sun cream on.
