Listen carefully to the story and talk about some of the things that happen. Below are some ideas to develop the different areas of learning, as we do in nursery. Try something new each day. Remember to enjoy learning through play. Ask your child questions to develop and extend their learning.

## Have fun with phonics

Phonics-initial sounds/SATPIN

We are learning to hear and say initial sounds, this week the sound is 's'

'S'-sausages are sizzling s,s,s

Play Kim's game- put a selection of objects on tray beginning with 's' –cover, take an object away-which object has gone?

We sing the song of sounds every day in nursery, practise the actions and saying the sounds



## Get moving!


Name writing- Practice writing their name-tracing/copying and independently

### Playdough Recipe

measure 2 cups of plain flour  
1 cup salt  
2 tablespoons of cooking oil  
2 cups of water (you can add food colouring)  
1 teaspoon of cream of tartar  
Mix then cook in a saucepan  
Cool then knead (keep in fridge)
