




WEEK 1- The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch

Name writing- Practice writing their name-tracing/copying and independently


Encourage your child to Dress and undress independently

Playdough Recipe

- Measure 2 cups of plain flour
 - 1 cup salt
 - 2 tablespoons of cooking oil
 - 2 cups of water (you can add food colouring)
 - 1 teaspoon of cream of tartar
- Mix then cook in a saucepan

Cool then knead (keep in fridge)


Making a seagull

Can you write some numbers in the sand?




- Can you collect some stones or shells to make numerals?
