




WEEK 2- The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch

Have fun with phonics



Continue to have fun with phonics with a focus on SATPIN
Big Cat phonics -song of sounds

We sing the song of sounds every day in nursery, practise the actions and saying the sounds

Can you write the letters SATPIN on bottles, fill them with water to keep them stable, can you throw a hoop over one? Or knock it over with a bean bag? Which sound is it? Can you move the bottles to make CVC words? For example Sam, sat, tin.

Make a sandwich



In the story, Mrs Grinling made lots of delicious food for Mr Grinlings lunch. Can you make a sandwich for your lunch? This activity helps your child to listen and follow instructions one-step at a time. It also supports their independence, fine motor skills and making healthy choices.

What is your favourite filling?

How many pieces have you cut your sandwich into? Enjoy!

Reading

Share story books every day. Turn the pages and talk about what they can see in the pictures.

Name writing- Practice writing their name-tracing/copying and independently
