


Our topic for this half-term is 'We're all Going on a Summer Holiday'

Have fun with phonics



Continue to have fun with phonics with a focus on SATPIN

Big Cat phonics -song of sounds

We sing the song of sounds every day in nursery, practise the actions and saying the sounds

Write letters on paper and collect a number of items to put in a box. Pick an object. What is it? Can your child can hear and say the initial sound of the object. Can they recognise the letter and place the object on it?

Make a Jellyfish



Can you make a jellyfish? You can use a disposable bowl to make a 3D one or a paper plate to make a 2D jellyfish.

Then you will need, tissue paper, ribbon or bubble wrap strips to make the tentacles.

Encourage your child to Dress and undress independently



Can you move in different ways, like a crab, starfish or a jellyfish?

Floating and sinking



Experiment with your child to see which objects sink and which float.

Collect a number of objects together, talk to them to see if they think it will float or sink. What will happen to it if it floats?

What will happen to if it sinks?

Why do they think it will float/sink?

Try a sponge, talk about the change in state as it absorbs water

Crab handprint

Just like when you made a spider handprint, can you make a crab?

How to crabs move?




Maths -mark-making



Using water and a paint brush experiment with mark-making numerals

Can you copy over the numeral? Can you write it independently?



Can you make marks to represent a number? 3 circles or 3 lines

Learn a Nursery Rhyme Can you learn a nursery rhyme?

Five little ducks went swimming one day,
Over the hill and far away,
Mother duck says quack, quack, quack,, quack
But only 4 little ducks came back

This is a real favourite in nursery, encourage your child to represent the numerals using their fingers
